**Wethers – No intact Bucks – horns must be tipped or removed**

Wethers will be weighed by show officials' Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, 7:00AM. The minimum weight will be 35 pounds and maximum weight will be 125 pounds. Wethers must be carrying all milk teeth at weigh in time – if showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show. Wethers will be divided into four (4) weight classes as equal as possible - number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and at the show officials' discretion).
